## Eastside Mixing and Drying Activity:

- Loaded out wet soils from SW-5 with CAT 345 excavator (4) trucks hauled 140 loads @ 20 cy/load = 2,800 cy. Spreading at dry ponds.
- Tractor and pans 57 loads @ 30 cy/loads = 1,710 cy prepared material 1 tractor.
  Watered haul Rds and Maintained them with 4,000 gal Water truck and Motorgrader.
- CAT 324 Long Stick excavator, No activity. Being repaired.
- Continued pumping water from SC-1 to SW-12.
- D6 Dozer and 2nd Water truck continued roughing in haul roads on dry ponds, east side.
- Backfilled conduit trench for telephone.
- -Constructed contaminated test pads (completed 2 of 3). Utilizing 345 excavator, D6 dozer, 40 ton haul truck, smooth drum roller and water truck. Hauled 10 loads of contaminated soils from stockpile.

-Impacted soils over Phase 3A, continued power screening 1" minus soils. No activity.
-Excavated excess western ditch material from area south of Phase 1. Scraped access road ramp leading into Phase 1.

Phase 2, excavated silt and sediment from potholes. backfilled with rock to 1 foot above water level. Left open to check recharge.

-Hauled 10 loads of engineered fill from stockpile to western ditch overexcavation for stormwater channel and placed one foot lifts. Continued fence installation in Tronox and Timet property for haul road construction.
